One or more bursaries may be offered each year to players that played the previous season on a Midget Travel or House League Team. Bursary amount will be dependent upon the number of applicants.

To be eligible for a bursary, the candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Must have been registered and played hockey with SFHA for the past three seasons.
- Must be graduating from high school this year.
- Must be attending a post-secondary educational facility and show proof of acceptance.
- Must demonstrate good sportsmanship, leadership skills, team commitment and positive attitude both on and off the ice during the current season.

The candidate will submit the following documents to be reviewed by the Committee.

- Completed SFHA Bursary Application
- An "expression of interest" letter describing why you should be chosen
- two letters of reference, with at least one of your hockey team's coaching staff
