- Sault Female hockey teams will play against each other, and have regularly scheduled exhibition games against teams at the Soo Pee Wee and Sault Major.
- Divisions will be aligned to start the year, with a check point during the month of December. If the teams need to move to a different division, this will take place in the new year.
- Sault Female will have their schedule posted from September December, with the January March schedule to follow.

- Teams will have one practice and one game per week, unless there is a local tournament which would dictate otherwise.
- To sustain the additional ice time costs, there will be a need for some fundraising to be done with the assistance from both our Jr. and Sr. VPs of House League and the Fundraising Committee.
